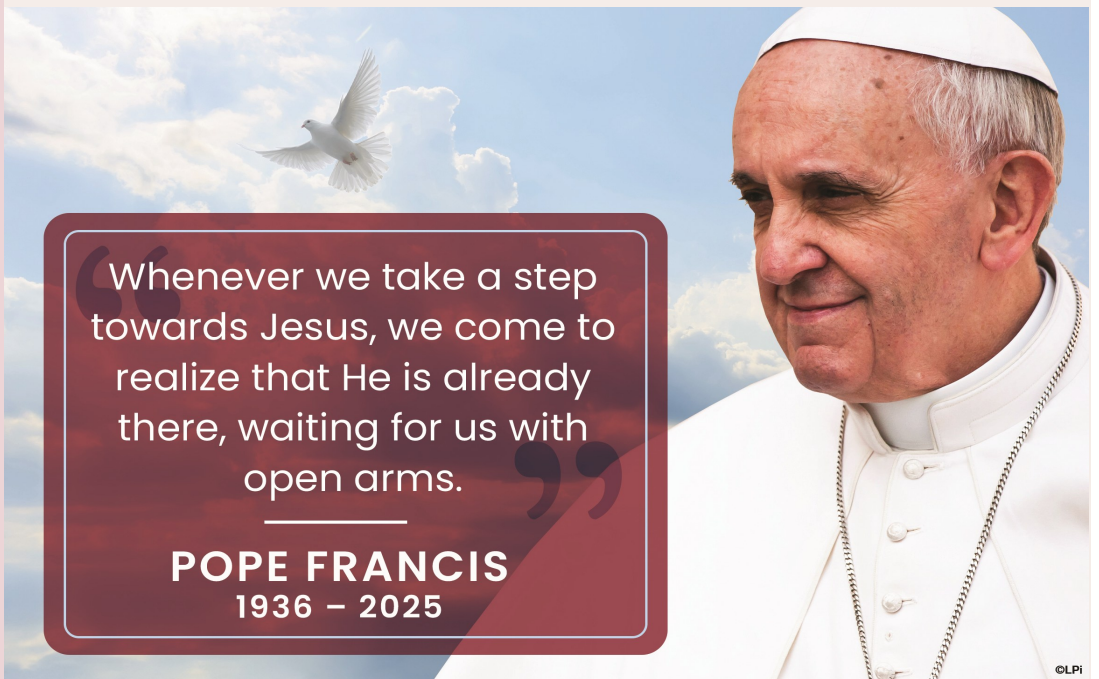
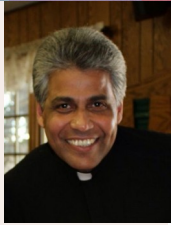
I would imagine that most of us have heard by now that Pope Francis passed away on Monday, April 21st. He was buried in the Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome after his funeral Mass which took place in Saint Peter's Square on Saturday, April 26.

I invite everyone to keep Pope Francis in your prayers as we mourn his passing and pray for the repose of his soul. There are many ways that we can do this. We can offer our favorite prayers up for him, and/or we can perform a variety of penances or sacrifices on his behalf. After the Masses this weekend I will be leading prayers which are a part of the indulgences offered to us as part of Divine Mercy Sunday.

The intentions of our prayers should include the process of selecting the next Holy Father. The upcoming conclave will begin shortly after the funeral of Pope Francis. Conclave is word meaning an enclosed room or a place that can be securely closed and generally refers to the process by which the Cardinals of the Church gather to select the next Pope. All Cardinals are invited to Rome for this time but only those under the age of 80 participate in the voting process which ultimately ends up with the white smoke rising from the chimney of the Sistine Chapel. The Cardinals are literally locked into a space from the inside and the outside. Any communication with the outside is so forbidden that to do so would result in loss of office and excommunication. Let us pray for these Cardinals, the process, and that we receive a good and holy shepherd. And of course, continue to pray for the repose of Pope Francis' soul.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

First Reading:

Many signs and wonders were done among the people at the hands of the apostles.

Psalm:

Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting.
Or: Alleluia.

Second Reading:

When I caught sight of him, I fell down at his feet as though dead. He touched me with his right hand and said, "Do not be afraid."

Gospel:

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you."

Gospel Meditation:

It's common for Catholics to hear the question, "Why do I have to go to a priest to have my sins forgiven?" I've never liked that question because not only is it clunky (confession is the ordinary way for the pardoning of serious sins, not lesser ones). But it misses the larger context: the wonderful origins of the sacrament itself. And this context is deeply Jewish.

Ancient Jews associated forgiveness of sins with priests offering sacrifices in the Jerusalem temple. It was a solemn, public, and tangible way to access God's mercy. So when the risen Jesus breathes on the Apostles and says, "**Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained**" (John 20:23), the upshot is remarkable: he is the new temple and his Apostles are the new priests. Jerusalem is no longer the place to find forgiveness from sin. Jesus' body, the Church, is.

So why should we go to the Sacrament of Confession? For the same reason ancient Jews went to the temple in Jerusalem: to experience the intimacy, joy, and life-giving power of God's eternal forgiveness.

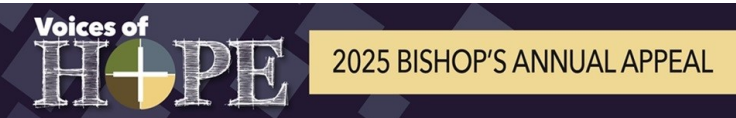
KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

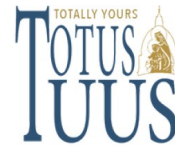

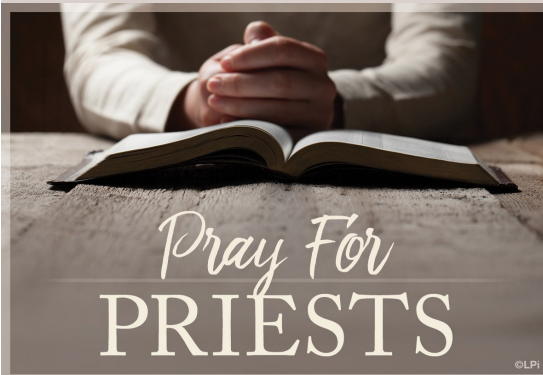

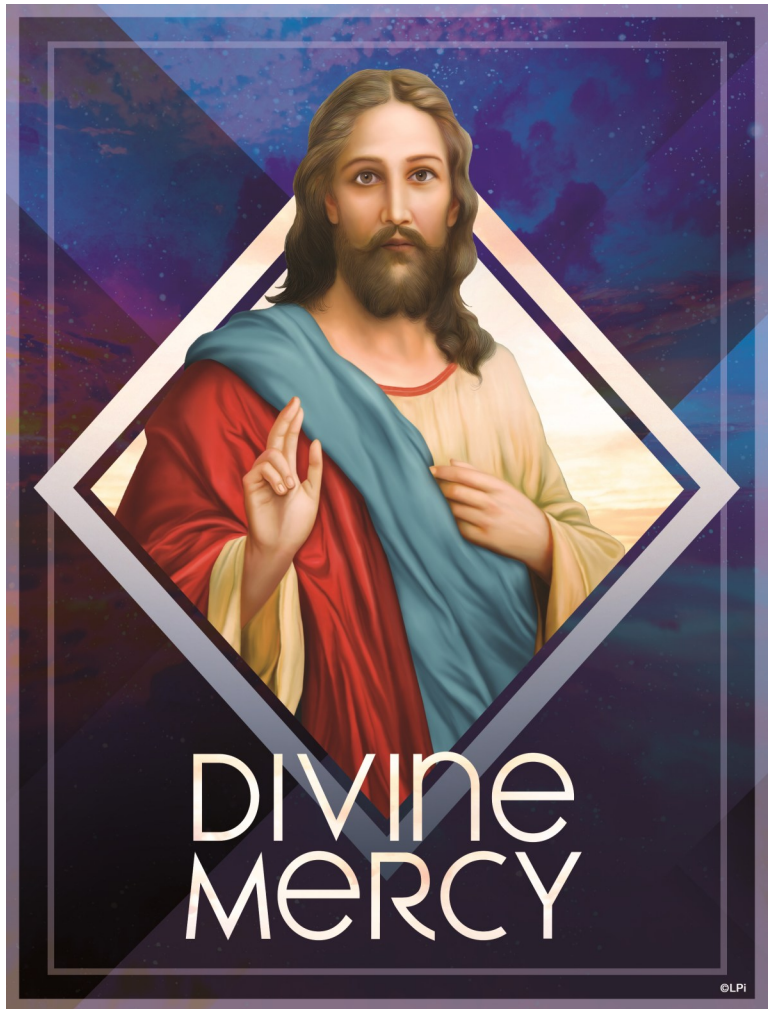
