

#### Greetings

"O Come, O Come, Emmanuel". And just like that, we're back in Advent, the season of hopeful waiting. It's hard to believe that we are only a few weeks away from Christmas.

One of the most significant traditions of the Advent season is the fourcandle Advent wreath. The concept of the Advent wreath originated among German Lutherans in the 16th Century. However, the Roman Catholics in Germany began to adopt the custom in the 1920s and in the 1930s it spread to America.

The wreath is a circle, which has no beginning or end symbolizes the eternity of God, the immortality of the soul, and the eternal life we find in Christ. God is eternal, and His love for us is everlasting.



The flames of candles are a representation of the Christmas light approaching, bringing hope and peace in the struggle against darkness.

- The first purple candle symbolizes hope. It is sometimes called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, especially Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ. It represents the expectation felt in anticipation of the coming Messiah. (Is 7)
- The second purple candle represents faith. It is called the "Bethlehem" Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. (Lk 2)
- The third candle symbolizes joy. It is called the "Shepherd's Candle," and is rose because rose is a liturgical color for joy. The third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday and is meant to remind us of the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus, as well as the joy that the faithful have reached the midpoint of Advent.
- On the fourth week of Advent, we light the final purple candle to mark the final week of prayer as we wait for the birth of our Savior. This candle, the "Angel's Candle," symbolizes peace. It reminds us of the message of the angels. (Lk 2)

Sometimes a white candle is placed in the middle of the wreath and is lit on Christmas Eve; this is a modern adaptation. This candle is called the "Christ Candle" and represents the life of Christ. The color white is for purity because Christ is our sinless, pure Savior.

Make the Advent wreath the centerpiece of your dinner table. Light it at dinner time, and pray, listen or sing Advent hymns instead of Christmas hymns, in preparation for the coming of Christ, with your family. This daily practice will help each member of the family keep focused on the true meaning of Christmas.



#### FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

#### **First Reading:**

"In those days, in that time, I will raise up for David a just shoot; he shall do what is right and just in the land."

#### Psalm:

To you, O Lord, I lift my soul.

#### **Second Reading:**

May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all just as we have for you, so as to strengthen your hearts, to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones.

#### Gospel:

"But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand."

#### **Gospel Meditation:**

When I was a young priest, about one year after ordination, I was called to the hospital to anoint a dving mother of three young children. She had a painful, terminal cancer. After celebrating Last Rites with her, I said, "Don't be afraid." She looked me square in the eye from her hospital bed and said, "Oh Father, I am in a lot of pain, but I am not afraid. Something wonderful is about to happen." A few days later she died.

Christians face the ending of our personal various "worlds" in a totally unique way. This first Sunday of Advent, Jesus says that when people see their world falling apart, they find themselves "fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world" (Luke 21:26). In our fear, our natural response is to check out, to hide our heads in drunkenness, distraction, and false securities. But Jesus commands us to "look up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." He then compares what's coming to a lovely summer in full bloom. That's what the cross and resurrection empower us to do, as strange as it may seem.

Advent challenge: What world in your life is collapsing? A relationship, a dream, a work opportunity? Maybe you're troubled by a crumbling world in the political or economic sphere. Or maybe someone you love is seriously ill or dying. Name that world or worlds. Then pray: "Lord, help me to not faint with fear. Help me to raise my head and see your redemption coming."



#### What is a Jubilee Year?

A Holy Year of the forgiveness of sin, conversion and joyful celebration.

The word "iuhiloo"

The word "jubilee" comes from the Hebrew word yobel, which refers to the ram's horn used to announce a jubilee in the Old Testament.

#### **Old Testament origins**

God told Moses that every fiftieth year was to be set aside for the return of absent members to their households, the restoration of land to its owners, the release of Hebrew slaves and the forgiveness of debts.

This fiftieth year you shall make sacred by proclaiming liberty in the land for all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, when every one of you shall return to his own property, every one to his own family estate. (Lev. 25:10)

Like the sabbath, which took place on the seventh day of each week, the jubilee was a time for the Israelites to re-establish a proper relationship with God and with one another.

#### THE JUBILEE PRAYER

Father in heaven, may the faith you have given us in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother, and the flame of charity enkindled in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, reawaken in us the blessed hope for the coming of your Kingdom.

May your grace transform us into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel.

May those seeds transform from within both humanity and the whole cosmos in the sure expectation of a new heaven and a new earth, when, with the powers of Evil vanquished, your glory will shine eternally.

May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, a yearning for the treasures of heaven. May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth. To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever. Amen.


