32009 County Hwy 74 Underwood, MN 56586 Mass Times Weekend: Sat. 5:00 pm Weekday: Wed. 9:00 am Speaking in the synagogue in Nazareth, Jesus used Isaiah's prophetic terms, (Is 61:1-3; Lk 4: 18-19), to describe his own mission "*to bring Good News to the poor*." The success of Jesus' mission, particularly with the poor who had no political power made Jesus a "dangerous" person to the religious authorities of Israel and eventually resulted in crucifixion. The Christian Gospel is still dangerous when its truth is really put into practice. This is clearly seen in the case of Archbishop Saint Oscar Romero of El Salvador, who was assassinated while he was celebrating Holy Mass. Like Jesus, he reminded people of the needs of the poor and the oppressed in El Salvador.

The story began in 1979 when a young priest, Father Grande, was shot and killed on the streets of El Salvador. His "crime" was that he spoke out against the government, which brutally suppressed all forms of protests


against the government, which brutally suppressed all forms of protests and executed thousands of innocent people using its notorious "*Death Squads*." When Fr. Grande's great friend, Bishop Oscar Romero, was chosen to be the new Archbishop, the authorities thought he would keep quiet on the question of the oppressed poor in that country. Instead, Archbishop Oscar Romero became an outspoken defender of the poor and a critic of the state-supported "*Death Squads*." To honor the memory of his martyred friend, Romero refused to appear in any public ceremonies sponsored by the army or the government. He soon became the voice and conscience of El Salvador. His words and actions were reported throughout the whole world, so that everybody knew the atrocities happening in El Salvador. On March 24th, 1980, as the Archbishop was offering Holy Mass in a hospital Chapel, a shot from the back of the Church struck him in the chest, killing him instantly. Thus, Archbishop Oscar Romero died a martyr for the

In 1997 Pope St. John Paul II bestowed upon Romero the title of Servant of God and a cause for his beatification was opened by the Church. He was beatified on May 23rd, 2015 by Cardinal Angelo Amato representing Pope Francis and canonized by Pope Francis October 14th, 2018, with the designation "Bishop and Martyr." During Romero's beatification Pope Francis declared that his ministry was distinguished by his particular attention to the most poor and marginalized. As we reflect on Jesus' words about his

mission, let us remember Saint Oscar Romero and continue to strive to live out faithfully in our world and in our daily lives the "dangerous" truths of the "Good News" which is Jesus' gift to us today.

THIRD SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

First Reading:

Ezra read plainly from the book of the law of God, interpreting it so that all could understand what was read.

Psalm:

Your words, Lord, are Spirit and life.

Second Reading:

For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

Gospel:

He said to them, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

Gospel Meditation:

A young couple in my parish told me they were expecting their second child, a baby boy. I knew that their five-year old only child Emma had been desperately wanting to be a big sister for years, so I said, "Emma must have been so happy when you told her the news." "Actually," they said, "she burst into tears. She wanted a baby *sister*!" How often in life God wonderfully fulfills our desires and we are sad because we don't approve of the *way* he does it. We want to control the gift and the delivery method.

The same thing occurs in the Gospel this week when Jesus announces in his hometown that the promise of an Anointed One bringing glad tidings to the poor is **"fulfilled in your hearing"** (Luke 4:21). After a moment of elation, his fellow townsfolk realize *this man* is the way God is fulfilling his promises, and they erupt into a violent outburst. So Jesus departs. How sad for them.

Every single Sunday at Mass, including this one, some version of this happens to many of us. God's word announces the fulfillment of God's promises in Christ, and we easily overlook or disdain it. His way is almost never according to our narrow expectations. What's required of us is to set these aside, and to embrace a new openness to God's gifts, no matter how he wishes to give them. God is fulfilling his promises the way He likes — why be sad?






