Greetings,

Lent will very soon be upon us. Beginning on Ash Wednesday we enter into the great season of increased prayer, fasting, and penance as we prepare for the highest of our solemnities: The Resurrection of the Lord. The practices of Lent are not simply actions of self-denial for the sake of self-denial. We offer sacrifices in different areas of our lives so as to better attach ourselves to the Cross. We offer suffering and sacrifice up as a prayer as we **remember that we are dust and to dust we shall return**. The Cross is a necessary preparation for the Resurrection.

Many of us are accustomed to giving up things that we like to eat or do as part of our Lenten penance. This a wonderful practice, but I would like to invite you to also consider adding something to your Lenten preparation as well. Perhaps we could add a decade of the Rosary to our prayer life if it is not something we already do. A Divine Mercy chaplet, the St Michael prayer, or an act of contrition at night would also be examples of increasing our prayer life. Reading the Sunday readings during the week for the upcoming weekend is also a good way to increase prayer in our lives. We may find that after an entire Lent of increased prayer that these good habits will stick with us throughout the year and hopefully our lives.

Let us prayerfully consider how the Lord is calling us to give of ourselves and grow this Lenten season.

FYI:

On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone of age 14 and up must abstain from consuming meat.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone of age 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt usually due to a medical reason.

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting.

## EIGHTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

### First Reading:

Praise no one before he speaks, for it is then that people are tested. (Sir 27:7)

### Psalm:

Lord, it is good to give thanks to you. (Ps 92)

### Second Reading:

But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor 15:57)

### Gospel:

“A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks.” (Lk 6:45)

### Gospel Meditation:

One of the things that older pastors and younger priests occasionally quarrel about is the proper balance between work and prayer. I know one pastor who complains that his younger associate ignores the people and the parish because he wants to spend more time in prayer. And the young priest complains that the pastor gives him too much work to do and no time to pray. The Lord’s words this Sunday speak into this tension with an image that can help us find a proper balance between life and prayer.

Jesus says, “**For every tree is known by its fruit. For people do not pick figs from thorn bushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles**” (Luke 6:44). When we are deeply rooted and cultivating our relationship with Jesus, we are going to bear the fruit of that love in our lives. No fruit, no good prayer. How do we know that we are praying well? We are experiencing concrete fruits of love for others in our lives.

Someone who prays well will, sooner or later, burst forth the “figs” and “grapes” of acts of love. But without concrete commitment to deeds of selfless service to others, our prayer time is as useless as thorn bushes and brambles. Let’s recommit ourselves to be men and women of prayer and service. And hopefully the pastors will help their associates to pray *and* serve fruitfully... With minimal quarreling.

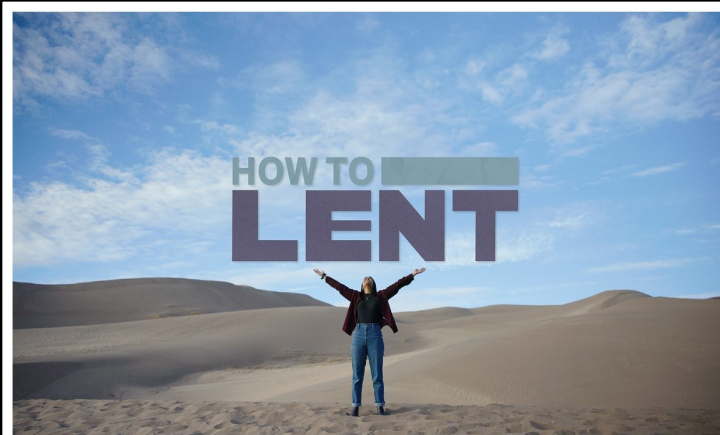

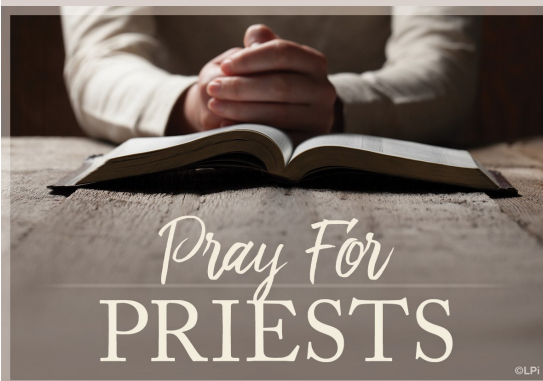
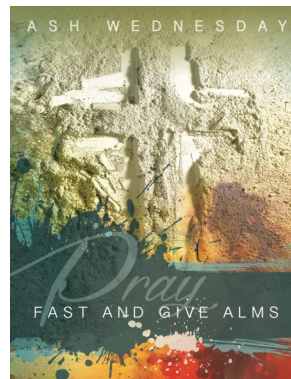
